



Mettl Employability Test

Test Instructions

The assessment will be divided into 2 tests Links:

(1) **MET for Everyone: Quantative Aptitude, Verbal Ability, Logical Reasoning, Attention to detail, Personality, Computer Fundamentals and Business Aptitude**

(2) **MET (Core Engineering): Core Engineering – Electronics, Core Engineering – Electrical, Core Engineering – Mechanical**

- Students belonging to MBA (All Departments), BBA (All Departments) , B.Com (All Departments) , B.Sc (All Departments) , B.Pharm (All Departments) , BA (All Departments) will only attempt **MET for Everyone**.
- Students belonging to Engineering, both **Under-Graduation and Post-Graduation**, will attempt **Quantative Aptitude, Verbal Abiity, Logical Reasoning, Attention to detail, Personality compulsory**. They have an option to choose and attempt **any 2 sections** out of **Computer Fundamentals, Business Aptitude, Core Engineering- Electronics, Core Engineering- Electrical, Core Engineering – Mechanical**
- **In case of Core Engineering, the following will be followed:**

Section Name	Applicable Branches
Core Engineering- Electrical	Electrical Engg, EEE Engg (Both UG, PG)
Core Engineering - Mechanical	Mechanical Engg, IP Engg, Automobile Engg (Both UG, PG)
Core Engineering - Electronics	ECE, Instrumentation, Applied Physics, Applied Sciences (Both UG, PG)

- Negative Marking will be applicable to the following sections, **1/4th** the total marks: **Quantative Aptitude, Verbal Ability, Logical Reasoning, Computer Fundamentals, Business Aptitude, Computer Fundamentals, Business Aptitude, Core Engineering- Electronics, Core Engineering- Electrical, Core Engineering – Mechanical**
- Overall Test duration will be between **120 to 160** minutes, depending on what the candidate chooses.

- Every Engineering Graduate/ Post – Graduate will attempt at least **7 sections from MET for everyone** and **MET (Core Engineering)**. Non –Engineering candidates will attempt at least **6 sections from MET for Everyone**.
- All students attempting MET (Mettl Employability Test) will have to fill this form before attempting the test. <http://tests.mettl.com/drive/met-signup/>. Students should carry a ID card scan copy in size of 50-150 KB that will be required to fill this form
- All students should NOT browse away from the test window during the test. This will be treated as malpractice and the candidate will be disqualified.
